Dear Mr. Lawrence:

As you know, the State reviews the full range of public review planning documents released by the National Park Service. There are at least six State agencies that participate in these reviews usually through staff that are located in several locations across the state. In order to effectively review these documents in a timely manner, State agencies need a sufficient number of copies to distribute to the various reviewers.

In the past we have had no problem receiving enough copies of documents in public review (up to 50 during the GMP days). Recently, however, we have not been receiving as many copies as we need. When we are short, we have had to xerox extra copies, which is cumbersome, time-consuming and, if maps are involved, often inadequate.

I have checked with those State agencies that have been active in CSU plan review and have determined the number of copies we currently need to conduct a thorough review. For park units in southeast, southcentral and southwestern Alaska, we request a total of 33 copies to cover our distribution list. For park units in interior and northern Alaska (including Wrangell-St. Elias), we request 35 copies.

Regarding distribution to State agencies, the easiest approach for both the NPS and the State is for the Division of Governmental Coordination to handle the initial distribution to the primary State agency representatives, who in turn forward the document to the appropriate individual reviewers, accompanied by information regarding internal review schedules, etc. This relieves NPS from having to continually update fluctuating mailing lists. (Saves postage too!)
