Assessment (EA), Brooks Camp, Katmai National Park and Preserve


Dear Mr. Pierce:

The above-referenced CAP/EA provides an analysis of remediation alternatives to address underground storage tank fuel leaks at Brooks Camp in Katmai National Park and Preserve. According to the analysis described in the EA, there would be no effect on coastal zone resources from the preferred alternative / proposed action (Alternative 5). Therefore, in accordance with federal regulations 15 CFR 930.35(d), you provided to the State a negative determination for Alternative 5 in your letter dated February 11, 1997.

Copies of the CAP/EA have been circulated to selected state, borough, and other reviewers. No comments disagreeing with the negative determination were received. The State agrees with the determination that no significant impacts are likely to spill over from federal lands onto the coastal zone as a result of this project as proposed in Alternative 5, and therefore no consistency determination is required.
