Pursuant to AS 16.05.841 and AS 16.05.871(b), the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) Division of Habitat reviewed your request to amend FH11-I-0123 to reflect design modifications of the reconstructed Greens Creek fish pass.


#### **Project Description**

You reconstructed the Greens Creek fish pass in March, 2016. To increase strength and durability of the three fish pass weirs, you built each weir using concrete, rather than timber, and attached steel caps. You did not reconstruct the log jam upstream of the fish pass as the feature was not necessary to facilitate fish passage or intended to be maintained in perpetuity.

In accordance with AS 16.05.841 and 16.05.871(d), permit FH11-I-0123 is amended to reflect design modifications of the Greens Creek fish pass. All other terms from the original permit remain in place.
