Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), Wastewater Discharge Authorization Program received and reviewed APDES Permit AK0038652 renewal application submitted on March 3, 2022. The timely application was determined administratively complete. Under DEC regulation 18 AAC 83.155(c)(1), an APDES permit remains fully effective and enforceable if a timely and complete application is received, and through no fault of the permittee, DEC did not reissue a new APDES permit prior to the expiration date of the existing permit. That means your existing permit, which expired after August 31, 2022, remains effective and enforceable until a new permit is issued to your facility.
