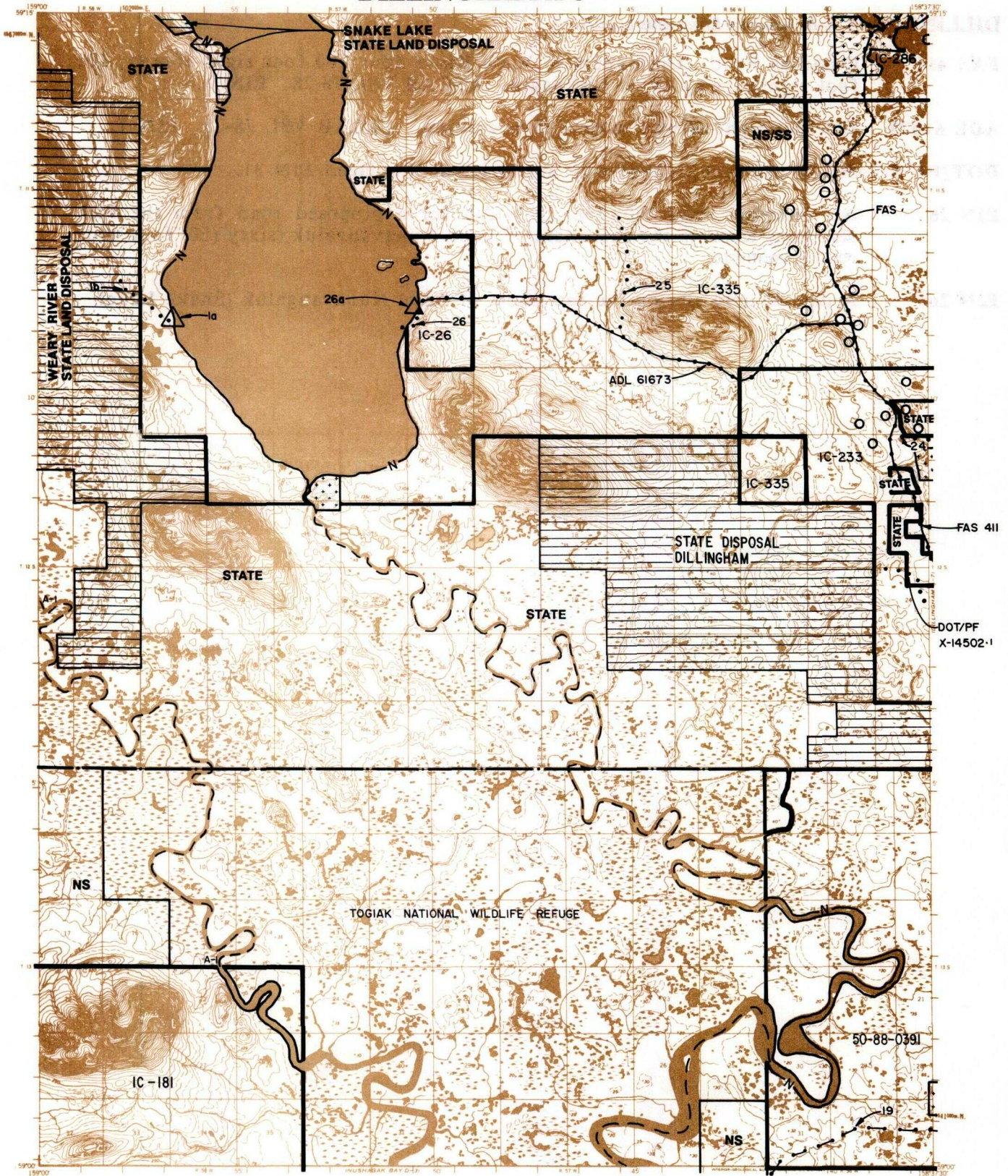

RESERVED EASEMENTS

- EIN 1a One (1) acre site on the west shore of Lake Nunavaugluk (Snake Lake).
- EIN 1b Access trail from the west shore of Lake Nunavaugluk (Snake Lake) westerly to public lands (25 foot trail).
- EIN 19 Dillingham-Manokotak existing access trail from the Nushagak River southwesterly to public lands (25 foot trail).
- EIN 24 Proposed access trail in the vicinity of Belt Creek from the Dillingham-Aleknagik Road easterly to the Wood River and public lands (25 foot trail).
- EIN 25 Proposed access trail from the switch-back located on the Snake Lake Road northerly to public lands (25 foot trail).

DILLINGHAM A-8 *Reserved Easements continued*

- FAS 411** Omnibus Road. Dillingham to Wood River Spur 200 foot right-of-way, 100 foot right-of-way on to Aleknagik. ANCAB VSL 78-28. EIN 9.
- ADL 61673** 100 foot right-of-way subject to upgrading. ANCAB VSL 78-28. EIN 7.
- DOT/PF X-14502 #1100** 100 foot right-of-way unrestricted. Replaced EIN 31.
- EIN 26** An easement sixty (60) feet in width for a proposed road from the Fish Hatchery Road to the east shore of Lake Nunavaugaluk (sixty (60) foot wide road easement).
- EIN 26a** A one (1) acre site on the east shore of Lake Nunavaugaluk (Snake Lake).
