EIN 22

A campsite on the left bank of Olga Creek near the outlet of lower South Olga Lake. (one-acre site)

EIN 24

A campsite at the mouth of Olga Creek on lower South Olga Lake. (one-acre site)

EIN 26

A campsite on Olga Creek at the outlet of upper South Olga Lake. (one-acre site)

EIN 29

A proposed trail running easterly from Olga Bay at site EIN 29a. (25-foot trail)

EIN 29a

A campsite on the east shore of Olga Bay near Olga Narrows. (one-acre site)

EIN 37

A proposed trail running easterly along an unnamed creek from Moser Bay at site EIN 37a. (25-foot trail)

EIN 37a

A campsite on the east shore of Moser Bay. (one-acre site)

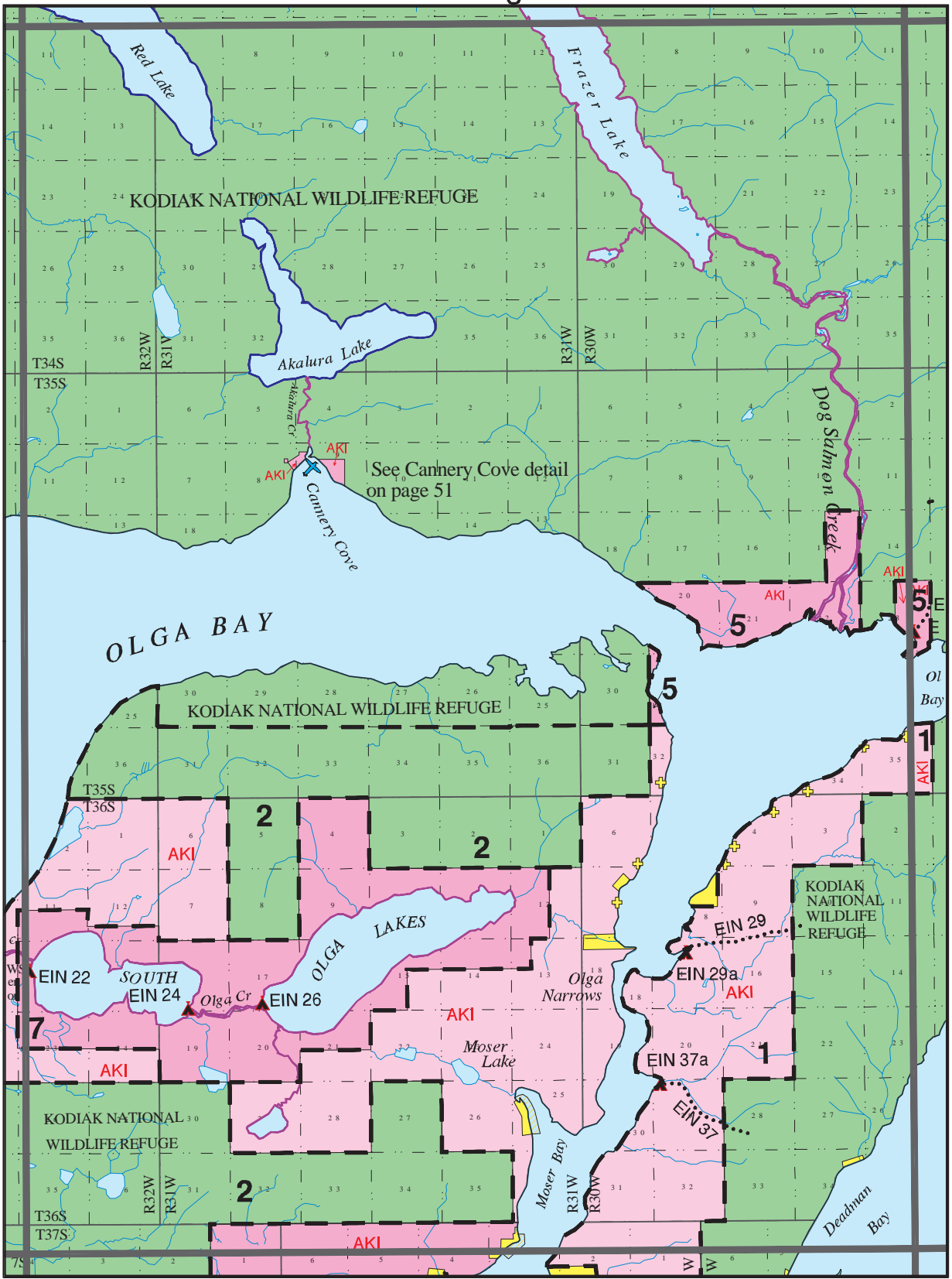
Land south and west of Olga Bay will become "Native, public access by permit only"

Permits require payment of a reasonable fee. Contact the corporation for further information. Legal access provided by FD 137-22 thru 226. This land will be conveyed to the USFS&WS in fee no later than September 30, 1997.

USGS Quadrangle Karluk A-1

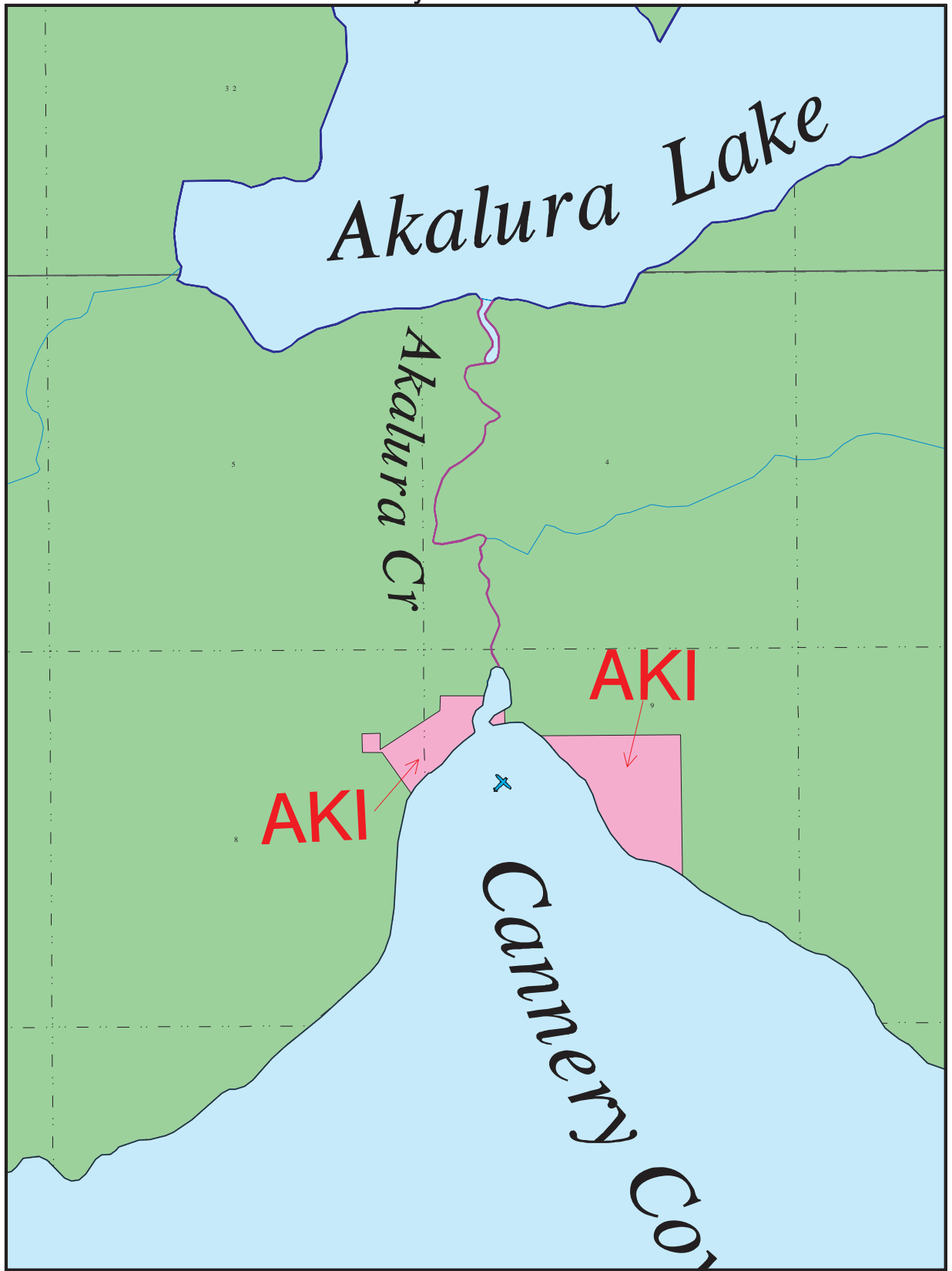
