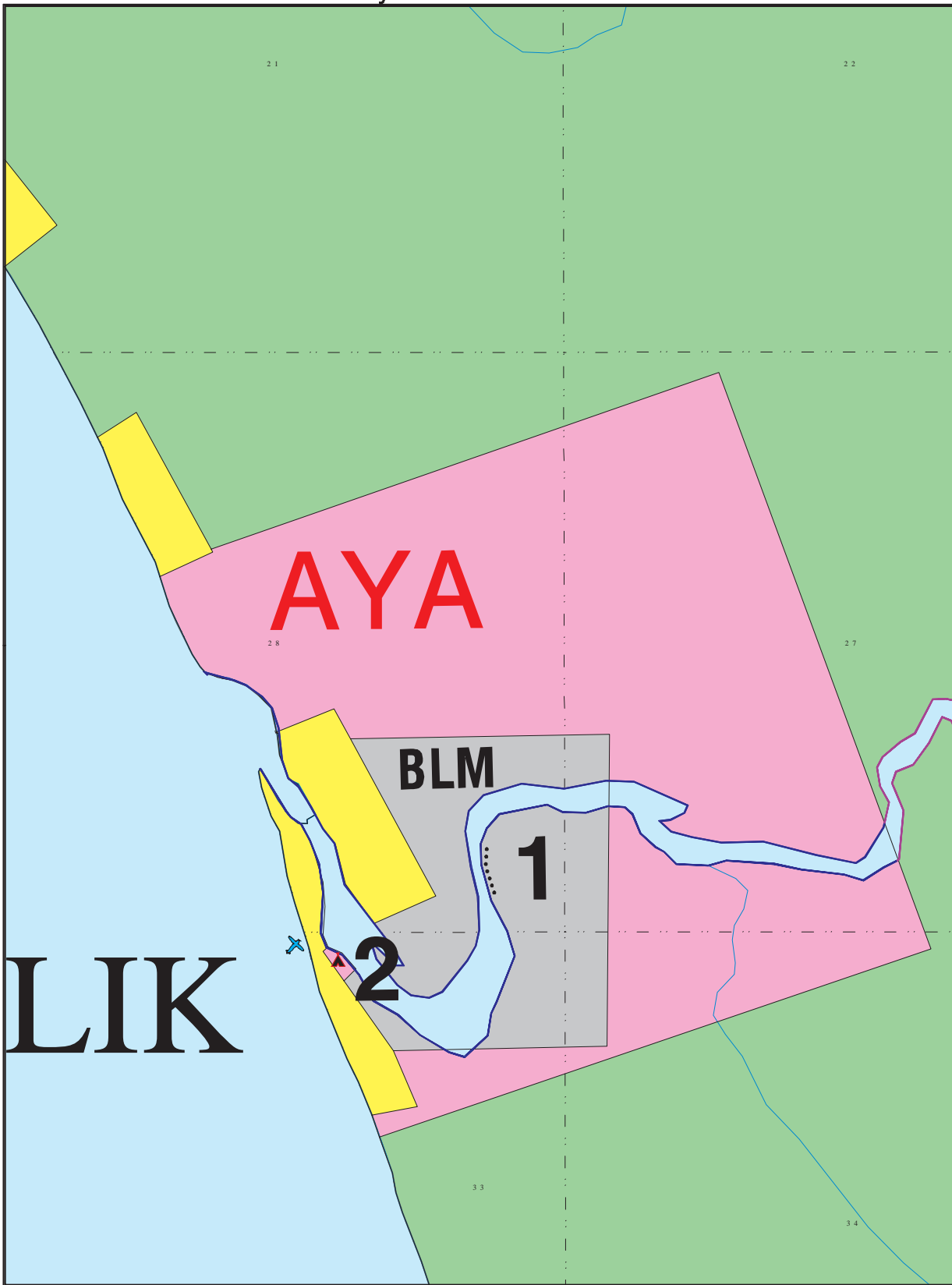

SUPPLEMENTAL LEGEND (keyed to bold numbers on Ayakulik detail)

Conveyance of BLM land at Ayakulik is presently on appeal. A proposed settlement of the appeal will provide the following state easements:

- 1** a portage easement 25 feet in width by 100 feet in length, on the left bank of the Ayakulik River around the existing weir (25-foot trail)
- 2** a campsite 100 feet in length by the width of the spit adjacent to Mineral Survey No. 247. (staging and camping area)
