Conditions update:

The Nancy Lake Parkway is plowed and open to the Redshirt Lake Trailhead.

The park will close to snowmachine use at dusk Sunday, April 21. Call ahead for updates 495-6212.

Temps are now above freezing. Use caution as overflow exists off packed trails, especially Lynx Lake, (north end) and Red Shirt Lake.

The lakes will be breaking up soon, watch for thin ice and recreate safely.

A \$5 day-use fee or annual parking pass is required at most trailheads throughout the park. Please respect private properties adjacent to park land. All snowmobiles must have their current registration tags displayed when used on public lands.
