The Alaska State Parks Kenai Regional Office has opened the application process for vacancies on three Kenai Peninsula Advisory Boards. The Kenai Special Management Area, Kachemak Bay State Park, and Seward State Parks advisory boards are recruiting for positions that will be vacated by current members having served a three-year term.

Alaska State Park advisory boards provide State Park managers with recommendations on management issues impacting State Parks. Individuals selected for these positions will serve a three-year term from July 2024 through June 2027. Advisory Boards typically meet once per month from September to May.
