

## 1860s Alaska Traveling Exhibit



The Alaska Office of History and Archaeology has created a traveling exhibit, *1860s Alaska*, for commemoration during 2017 of the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Treaty of Cession. The exhibit consists of eight free-standing, 8' x 3' banners. They can be viewed at [www.dnr.alaska.gov/parks/oha/1860sAlaska](http://www.dnr.alaska.gov/parks/oha/1860sAlaska). The exhibit is available for a three-week period and requests will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis.

The banners are one-sided pop-up vinyl panels. They will be shipped in two 40-pound wheeled containers, each 12x19x41 inches in size. Instructions to set them up will be with the containers and are at [www.youtube.com/watch?v=OzQ8\\_B-Mdjw](http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OzQ8_B-Mdjw).

- This is an inside exhibit. The banners are to be displayed where they can be watched when they are available for the public to view them, and the exhibit area must be secure when the building is closed. The containers need to be stored in a secure location.
- The host organization agrees to report any damage to the banners and stands to the OHA upon discovery. The host organization will be responsible for damage or loss to the banners due to neglect while on exhibit.
- The host organization agrees to pay the shipping costs to return the banners to the OHA in Anchorage. Estimates from shippers range from \$150 to \$400. For those on the road system, the OHA would like to have the exhibit picked up and returned by car.
