# TAKE-AWAY POINTS FOR INSTITUTING EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS LIKE PROJECT ARCHAEOLOGY:

- Educational programs like Project Archaeology Investigating Shelter can reach many students and shape student values.
- Costs can be relatively low for the number of students impacted.
- Creating the curricula is not enough to guarantee that the materials reach students.
- These programs, once instituted, may not necessarily be self-perpetuating.
