- Identify consulting parties
- Initiate consultation
- Determine schedule
- Provide meaningful opportunity to comment
- Create and send out documentation
- Confidentiality
- Delegation of authority



#### **COORDINATION BETWEEN NEPA AND SECTION 106**




The Public and Consulting Parties must be notified and given the opportunity to comment during each step of the Section 106 review process.

# Best Practices

- Make a consultation plan
  - Time of year
  - Lead time
  - Size and scope of project
- Consider staffing obligations
  - Regular staff meetings
  - Multiple projects
- Consult outside of projects
  - Establishing and maintaining relationships with consulting parties



# Best Practices

#### Allow sufficient time for comment

- Do not wait to contact SHPO
- 30 day review period
- Provide organized documentation
  - Clearly stated determinations and findings
  - Adequate information
  - Consider using tables for large numbers of sites
  - Maps and photographs
