Claire LeClair (Project Leader, Alaska State Parks) and Heather Rice (Rivers, Trails & Conservation Assistance Program) travelled to the Talkeetna/Trapper Creek area January 12-13 and met with individuals interested in the planning process. We plan to travel to the Talkeetna/Trapper Creek area regularly to meet with individuals and groups and to become familiar with the park. The planning team continues to focus efforts on gathering available information about the park and surrounding area, including land status, biological, physical and cultural resources and trends in recreational use. We have looked at eight seasons of registers from Ermine Hill trailhead and nine seasons of registers from Little Coal Creek trailheads for information about trail use. We reviewed comment letters from the South Denali Implementation Plan and Environmental Impact Statement (April 2006) for information pertinent to this planning process.
